

On Restriction at Sea Area around Runway D (Informed again) October 2011

Your cooperation is requested as navigation of vessels has been restricted on certain sea area around Runway D of Tokyo International Airport.

Establishment of Restricted Area

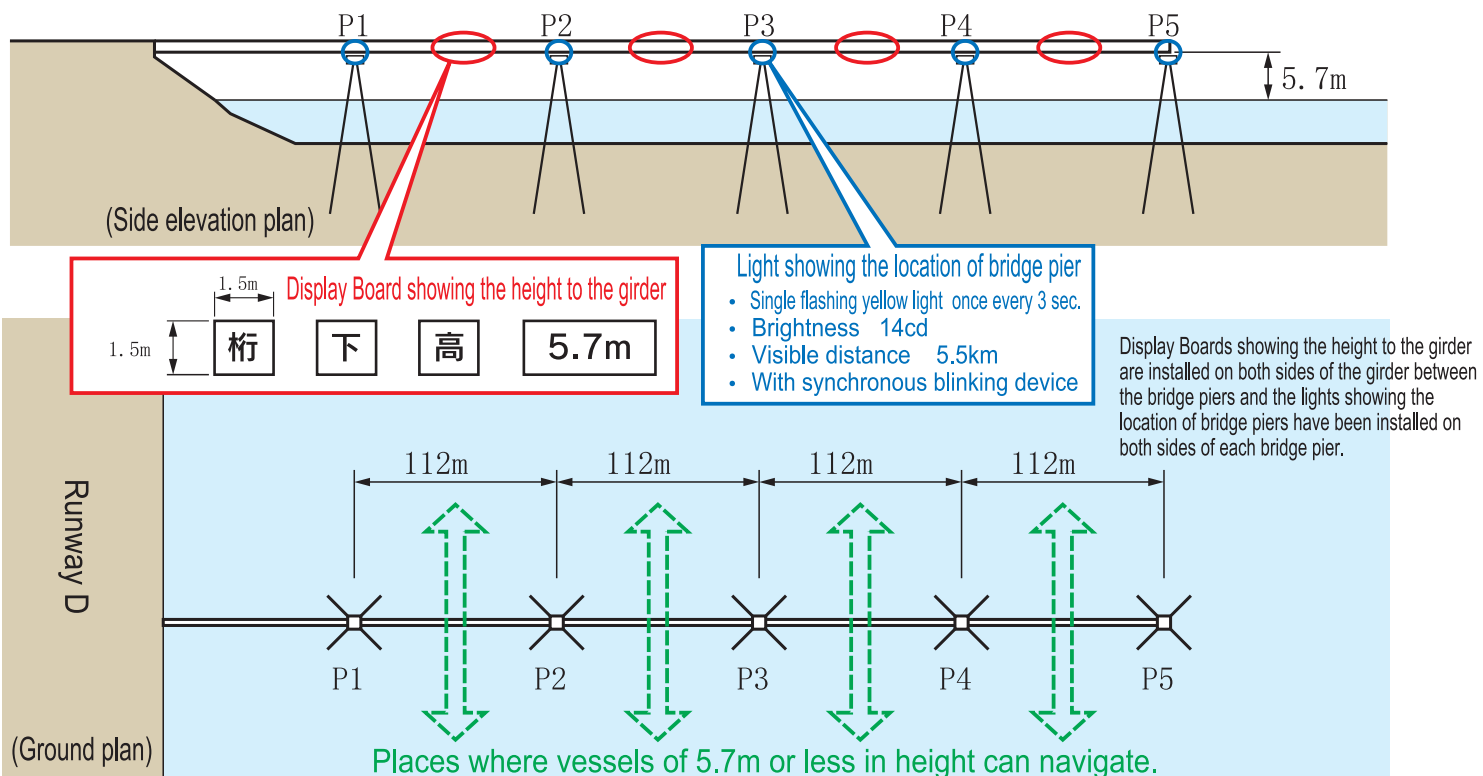
In order to prevent collision with the airport pier portion and illegal interference to airplanes, etc., vessels, excluding those approved by the airport chief, **can not enter the sea area** adjacent to the airport (**restricted area**) designated by yellow signs (29 in all) installed around Runway D island.

Guard boats are deployed to oversee the restricted area and call attention at around the surrounding sea area.

Height Restriction under Approach Light Bridge

Vessels of 5.7m or more above the sea level and vessels other than small type boats like fishing boats, pleasure boats, etc. (barge type tankers, barges, etc.) shall not navigate under the approach light bridge of Runway D but **navigate the northeast side of Tokyo International Airport Runway D East Light Beacon**.
